



**Enrollment Working Group
Meeting #1 Summary
April 5, 2016**

Key Points of Discussion:

- The group highlighted the importance of equity as a lens for enrollment Oakland by sharing personal stories of the impact of education on their lives and on those within their sphere of influence.
- The group developed norms on how members would work together. An emphasis was placed on keeping kids at the center and being transparent about the process.
- The group reviewed the governance structure of the Oakland Equity Pledge and the proposed guidelines from the Steering Committee
- The group wants to define the problem using the community survey, the Enrollment Blueprint and Strategic Regional Analysis (SRA), and analyze current examples of what exists and what is missing by learning from other district/charter compacts. From there, the group will select top items to focus on.
- Community involvement came up as a strong priority – the group needs to figure out the best ways to hear community feedback.
- The group decided that they will hold standing meetings every 3rd Monday from 5-7pm. They also blocked a tentative date for the first public engagement event: Monday May 16th from 5:30-7:30pm.
